



Der Film schildert das Schicksal von Klaus Schneider, der tatsächlich gelebt hat und als Hellseher und Magier Erik Jan Hanussen in Europa Furore machte. Als er in Berlin den Wahlsieg Hitlers voraussagt, werden die Nazis auf ihn aufmerksam. Sein entscheidender Fehler ist die Vorhersage des Reichstagsbrandes. Hanussen wird entführt und in einem Waldstück ermordet.

The film depicts the story of Klaus Schneider, a man who has actually lived and was known all over Europe as Erik Jan Hanussen, the clairvoyant and magician. When he foretells Hitler's victory at the polls in Berlin, the Nazis turn to him. His crucial mistake was to predict the Reichstag fire. Hanussen is abducted and murdered in a small forest.
